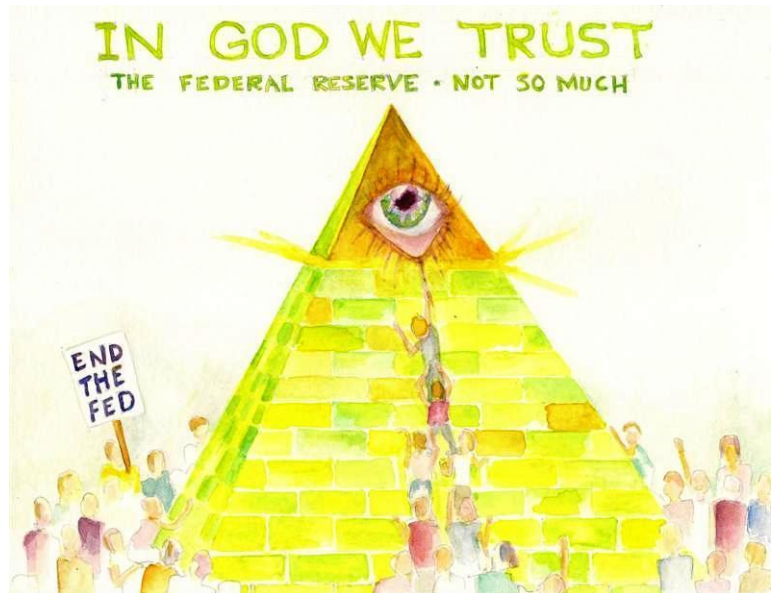


GOD WE TRUST - BANKERS NOT

War is trading people for resources - organized killing for profit – the basis of maintaining the business of peace. In the 1960s the youth under threat of being killed in a war for profit, thankfully rebelled, and today, similarly, the deceived youth, are the key to "*Occupying Wall Street*" protesting this slavery to a cartel that owns everything – including the ability to live. Yet, there is hope if we believe in the idealism of America, and with political maturity, we can come to a point where we reject the crimes of capitalism by rejecting the unjust, undemocratic power arrangements between high finance and its control of government.

Fascism is corporatism run amuck over flesh and blood; the real beneficiaries of the Fourteenth Amendment giving citizenship to slaves also gave citizenship to the artificial corporation. Despite claims to being just and rational, current economics evolved out of the slavery of plantations and factories; and modern policies governing employment and corporate subsidies came out of the struggle between owners and slaves that are still exploitative of the dignity of meaningful work while collapsing social relationships of accountability. The artificial citizen, banks especially, count more than the flesh and blood when they have usurped government policy at the expense of civil society. Despite America's past, vast wealth production, this arrangement would not return the "*sweat off the backs*" to working men and women grinded into the dirt by debts. Banks pose as good corporate citizens, but are philanthropic ogres peddling debts. There is no such thing as honest business when there are too many layers of corrupted professionals taking advantage between the source of, and the consumption of an economic way of life.

One may conclude that the long term legacy of one political regime after another are their militarized policies "*pushed*" in all spheres of government; militarist economics held together by debts through the barrel of a gun - the basis of the "*New World Order*" bankrupting America financially and morally. It's a failure in economic policy - a type of social psychosis of disconnectedness from realities of ordinary people in the grips of financial oligarchs which place blood money ahead of God, Country – and citizens. Such policies have rendered the nation with no qualitative employment and a bankrupt public unable to pay taxes to Leviathan state in the service of high finance. Voters believed likewise, but Barack Obama, is merely a representative of the power structure behind the theatrics of democracy, their vision of society is increasingly unable to be "*propped-up*" by ordinary people sent the bill through impoverishing tax schemes; and China, is no longer willing to subsidize America's problems due to criminal negligence by powerful money perverting society and state policies crafted in reaction to pathological outcomes.
