

FLIGHT TO FASCISM

What is fascism? Is it dictatorships be they communist or military? The answer is both! And even supposed democracy can have a streak of it! After the Second World War the US researched this question having just fought Hitler of Germany, the Japanese warlords, and then followed by confrontations with Stalinist Russia and Mao Zedong of China. What all these leaders had in common was the psychological need to impose their ideas, their ideologies upon the herd – and if need be through murderous means. However, despite contrasting ideologies, they all had one thing in common

– they had authoritarian personalities; and this view is psychological. From a psychological viewpoint in the research it is described as an authoritarian personality; or in more common terms - “*control freaks.*”



Americans love Knights of ole lore, they love the sting of battle, the competitive fight, and then to negotiate the truce called peace. America was founded upon a gun, a bottle of whiskey and a bible! Like any other society, in the name of goodness, her moralizing leaders suffer civil society by the misapplication of the means, war making on her own people expressing any disquieting voice, towards a mythical end – called a [Roman]democracy designed to protect feudalistic relationships between the airs of refinement and the rough, uncouth public. Arguably, the 14th and 15th Amendments re-enslaved the Negro freemen, who the white man feared, yet turned all citizens into slaves of state. Democracy allows for strong leaders, but provides mechanisms for leadership change so no one personality will take-over and impose their own pathologies – yet all do. However, since most patriotic leaders believe in the status quo favoring the financial and cultural aristocracy, they continue to reinforce long existing policies targeting what is referred to vernacularly as “*trash*” for behavioral attitudinal compliance – reinforcement in synch with neo puritan, feudalistic social relations.

The Patriot Act is a reactive, anti liberty policy by intentional design – designed by elitist thinking themselves entitled to be the guardians of correct political thought. Clearly the US has had a government that has built-up a technocratic apparatus meant at controlling citizens through surveillances that rivals the best in the worst of past authoritarian regimes whose primary policy was to spy upon its own citizens. This view was best expressed in the movie “*Enemy of State*” wherein we must ask: “*Who is watching the watchers?*”¹ Yet it is nearly impossible to watch the watchers when everything is labeled as “*classified.*” America is supposedly about the expression of creativity and freedom unfettered by the imposition of paranoia of state fearing its own citizens. Yet if one challenges the state and its penchant for war making – they too are targeted for surveillance – and given the movement towards defining dissent as possibly terroristic, eventually perhaps imprisoned and sexually tortured by prisons devoid of the pleasures of the society of opposite sex. Without serious thought as to the challenge it presents to the American psyche trained to be a strong individual – a strong expression of liberty – the authoritarian

personalities within the American family have rushed to impose a bureaucratic surveillance state bent on spying and molesting its own citizens – its own children. This of course was done in reaction to the terroristic attacks by a fanatical Islamic group formerly on the payroll of a state within a state - the CIA in Afghanistan during the war between the occupying Soviets and the local tribes. This fact has given rise to the credible allegation that the “*spook community*” was somehow complicit in these attacks upon New York and other American targets.

American was a nation that believed the likes of Hitler, Stalin, and Fidel Castro and their authoritarian ideologies were poisonous for humanity, and without fear of them, they were deserving of being disposed of before they disposed of our liberty. When liberty was a priority we ascended to world power and economic supremacy, but with a shift in priorities to dominate others through the barrel of a gun, now we have become another, large scale third world country of a small group of elites with the majority increasingly driven into poverty; and if one reacts to this perverse farce – then they are targeted by the instruments of the prison-industrial state for corrective action. Negligence of state and the politics of money have created the largest prison industrial complex in the world superseding authoritarian China and Russia. And so as China and Russia become freer, America has become more ensnarled in her own paranoia which requires making war upon itself. Unfortunately, the bulk of the prisoners in the American gulag system are not entirely classical pathological criminals, but people who are dependent upon what are labeled as illegal drugs to mentally make it through another day; in particular cannabis, mushrooms and peyote plants. Why is it authorities drunk with power insist upon the practice of moral entrepreneurship; of labeling plants and people who relate to them as morally deficient? America is a modern variant of its puritan past when everything was immoral – it is the basis of what its believes to be just war making that is always geared towards profiteering for a few as the reward of the citizens laboring away motivated by the protestant work ethic.

Rational Technology is a good thing when it serves to make human living a bit easier, but when humans serve technology harnessed to the business of moral entrepreneurship – then we have the basis of creating an alienated and sick people – a dehumanized society at odds with itself. However, people serving machinery of state is good for corporations selling fear as a means of creating a market for products sold as good for the welfare of humanity, but at the expense of nature and natural rights embodied in the Constitution. Today with technology, the creeps of state can place invisible tracers on citizens, spy on personal communications while recording voice-altering technologies that can string together words and form sentences one did not utter to turn any citizen into a terrorist, a drug gangster, or a criminal a rapist. No one who challenges the reality of fascism is safe from the enemies of freedom – the state within the state bent on usurping democracy from the public blinded to their nefarious activities.

A strong free people do not need fraudulent leadership. Yet how have we become blinded to the authoritarian fascism perpetrated upon a formerly free people? Perhaps when we have fraudulent leaders ruling through fear, we make for a weak people. Most people are conformist because in order to survive, it is better to go along than die on their feet opposing tyranny. Libertarians apparently are viewed as trouble makers – they turn in the direction of freedom when most turn towards conforming to bureaucratic tyranny wrapped in patriotism directed by elites that serve veiled interests not entirely healthy for the
