

THE DISPOSAL OF GADDAFI

The price of truth is high when the cost of ignorance is cemented by state lies. Revolutions always fail because like a propeller, political and religious ideologies revolve around symptoms without treating the core of social problems - the source of a lack of justice of prosperity and freedom for all. Revolutions come and go, but issues of end control of a nation's finances lie in other powerful realms that back any and all sides that cooperate in that economic equation.



During the 2011 Spring Revolt in Egypt, Diplomat Hillary Clinton, crafting tricky words - lies of

state playing to all villages, yet favoring some villages, initially backed President Mubarak by first rejecting the anti-government movement as sinking in the sand, then embracing the movement because the only thing sinking in the sands are the corrupt, monarchical and military regimes controlling the flow of oil. Powerful nations act as both pimp and whore requiring a state of cooperative complicity in guaranteeing mutual interests – power and finance. These two institutions are the means to economic ends not of good will, and justified by the means of the methods of a surveillance state whose primary clandestine policies cloak barbaric torture, murder and war - the business of maintaining the peace.

Yet with the abandonment of Mubarak, in order to guarantee control of the Suez Canal covert murder and torture by security forces continues with the tacit approval of Western power brokers needing to reign in Egyptian society dying to express itself. And likewise, Libya to enforce the control of oil supplies to European economies; allies that schooled the provincial Americans in the arts of imperial power. The *Old World Order* as envisioned by the West are the pimps, and the rest are essentially whores in economic bondage. In the competition for control of peripheral societies, the West cultivates their surrogates from a small class of exiled foreigners – her servants that are educated in the US, Britain and France, and later hold university positions as exiled leaders in waiting. All waiting for CIA provocateurs to destabilize a nation by any means possible in creating a state of social misery necessary to foment rebellion. Between economic embargoes, CIA provocateurs, and military interventions – these determinants are the ghouls fanning social unrest that in the Islamic context is the Devil come to visit.

In the case of Libya, without NATO bombings and arms support to disgruntled natives whose tribes were left out of the equation by Gaddafi, no flowering of a revolt could have streamed out of the deserts from the springs of discontent. provision of economic stability functioned for the majority of Libyans; worked for the majority, but not for competitive rivals. He was popular in Africa because he shared the oil wealth - he brought to the tribes - his people - water forth from the desert sands; he was a good host when he employed immigrants from interior Africa as laborers. But, he proposed that African gold and diamonds be the new benchmark for oil than the paper the Federal Reserve prints. Is it not interesting how the mainstream press was hailing the rehabilitation of the man, a man who gave-up any claims to nuclear power, now suddenly he is the “*boogey man*” again and he’s on some war crimes list at The Hague? He was the darling of Europe last year for giving-up on developing nuclear technology – and what did he do to get recertified as a threat – nothing but disarm, then compete against central US and European banks with his African schemes of independence from past colonized economies!

Gaddafi had surrendered to the status quo of the *New World Order* providing restitution and apology for the Lockerbie bombing, gave up a nuclear arms program, and invested much of the oil wealth into these international banks in an attempt to join the world peacefully. Gaddafi was double crossed - Libya was not a vital threat. We sympathize with the families of those murdered in the Lockerbie affair, yet we can also sympathize with the hundreds thousands of innocents murdered in Iraq under false pretense, and now the naked assassination of a rehabilitated foreign leader and his family. Libya was invaded by an instigated revolution carried out by the staged theatrics of Al Qaeda rebels fomenting rebellion creating another false pretense for war with no congressional approval, just a gangster like takeover of Libya with banks controlling assets. There are reports the rebels did unspeakable acts to Gaddafi; and that NATO bombed his motorcade which was flying a white flag of surrender. There was a time in war the enemy preferred to be captured by the Americans because we stood for open judicial proceedings for enemy leaders, yet spared soldiers carrying out the will their leaders. It is naive to think American leaders and their families will not now be vulnerable as targets. The danger of lowering moral standards of the codes of war, paints a target directly on our leader’s children. To treat an enemy without respect and provide no quarter to their family is foolish. If nations kill foreign leaders without trails, rape, and torture and beat enemy captives in secret jails, what can the US expect if the tide should turn? Nations that live by the sword shall suffer by the sword.

It is the white man’s diplomatic words that are walking death, and technocrats and politicians who remain silent are complicit in war crimes. But that condition of walking death was applied to Gaddafi who was tacitly murdered by the rebels in the employ of the European man in need of his colonies; and of course, the pious white man lamented with “*crocodile tears*” that it was a shame that Gaddafi was not properly trialed in a “*kangaroo court*” with a predetermined sentence of guilt. Meanwhile individual liberties are gutted under the guise of security. To understand this truth or oppose it means one is demonized as a potential enemy combatant. But the next society targeted for regime change, Iran, has learned from the Libyan affair, not to disarm in the face of a Western rehabilitation program conning them into submissions with economic embargoes that only hurt the powerless people. They know, that to become the next “*darling*” of Europe, means total

capitulation of autonomy to far away power only interested in milking assets resulting in poverty and social unrest. But this rejection of dominance by Iran has her labeled as a suicidal nation, but one might observe given a historical track record of constant war making, Western societies are homicidal.
